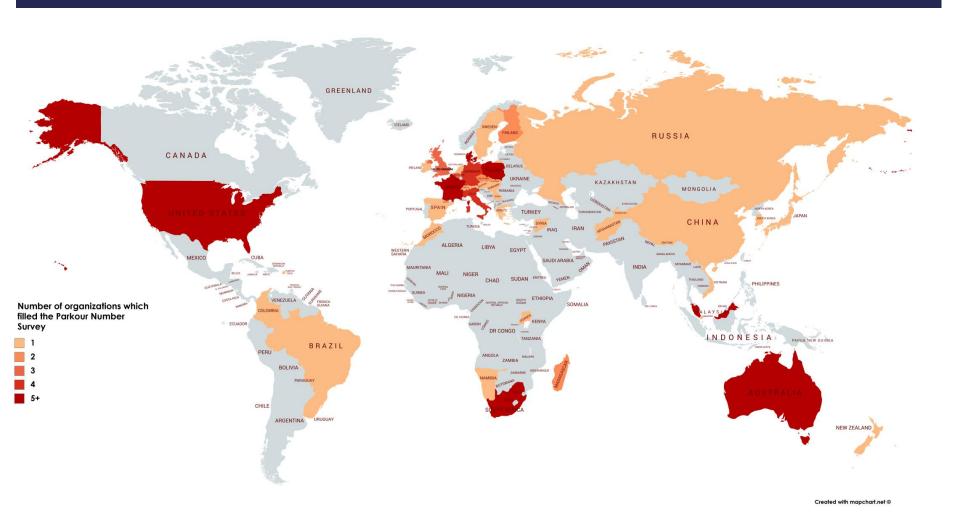
PREFACE

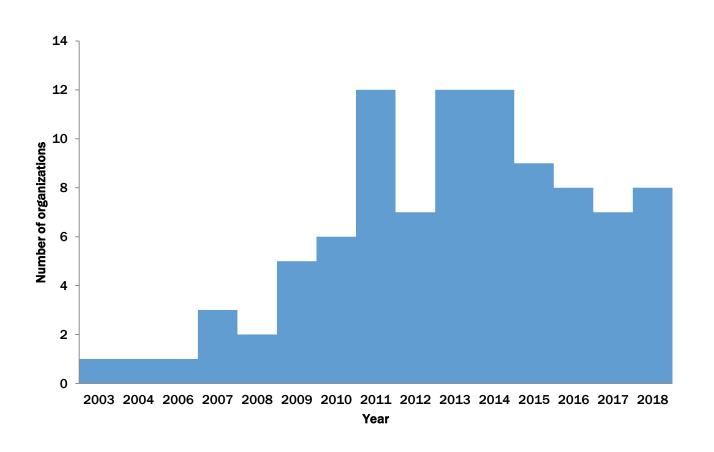

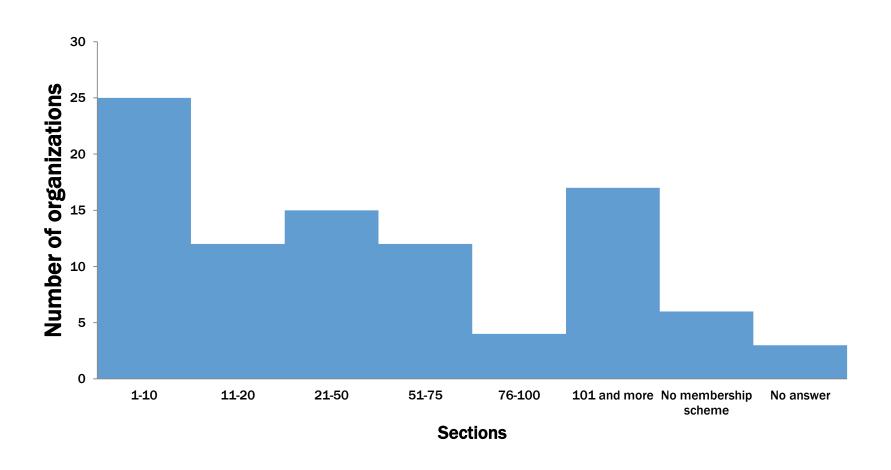

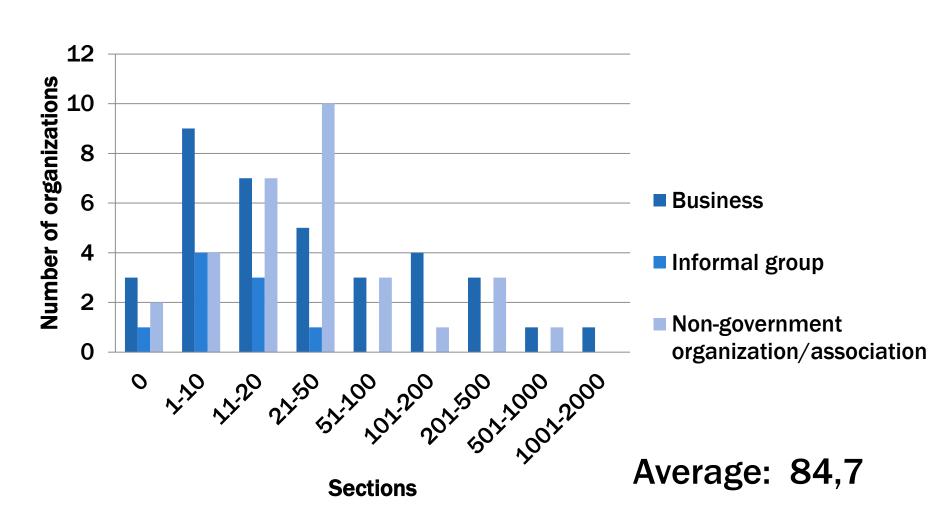

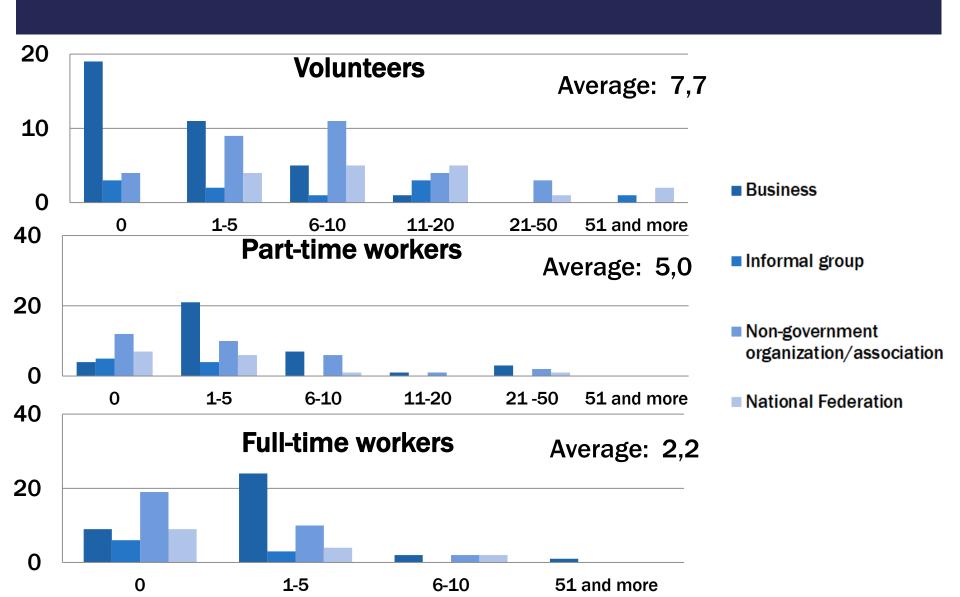
CLASS ATTENDANCE BY STATUS

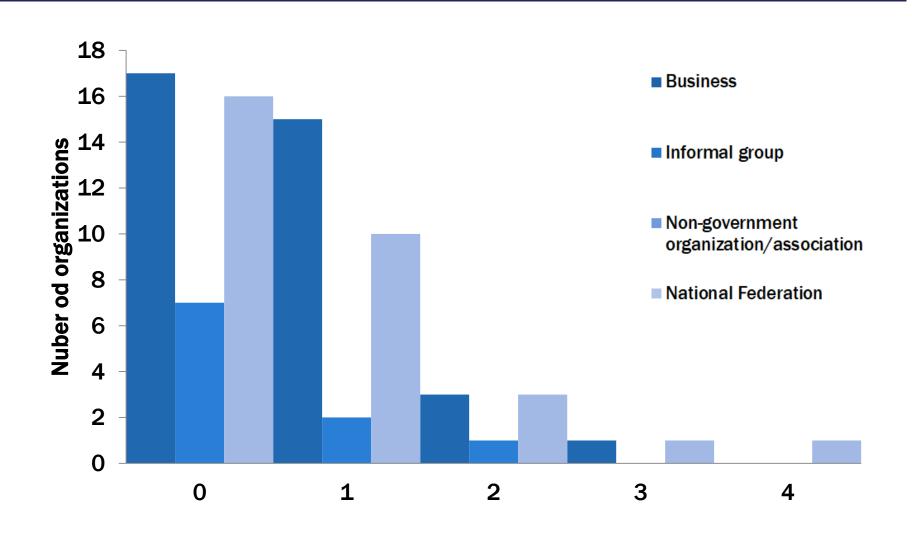

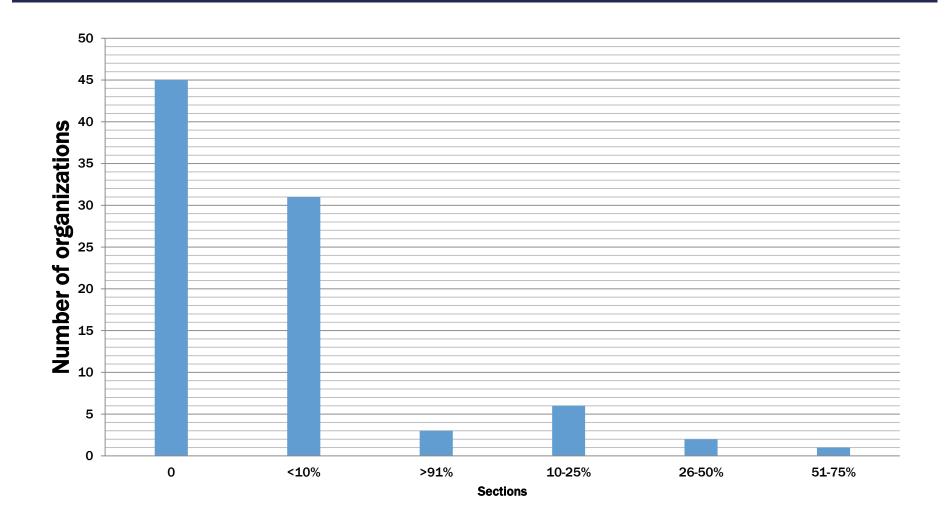


NUMBER OF MANAGED GYMS

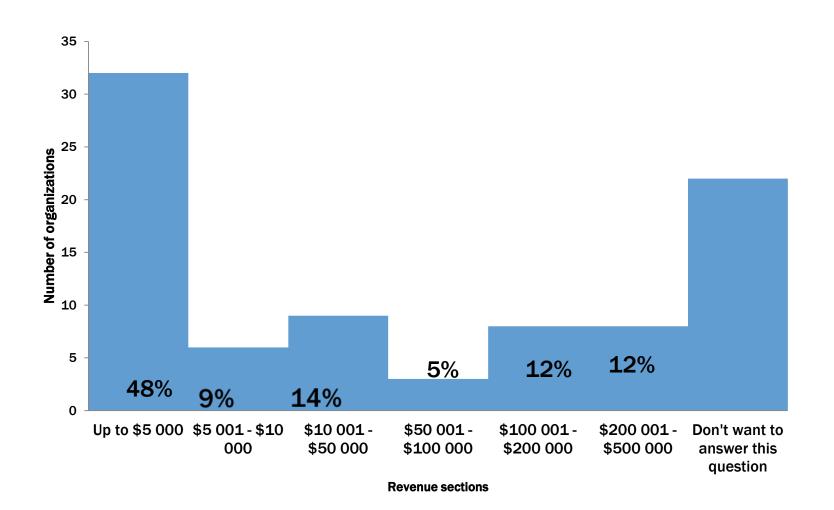

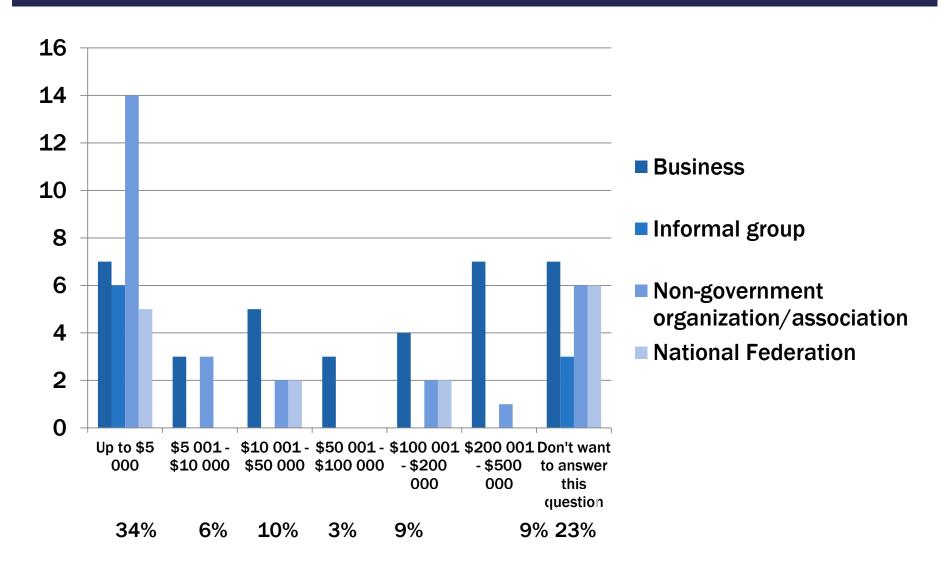
Q:ESTIMATED (IN US DOLLARS) YEARLY REVENUE/TURNOVER- THE ANNUAL INCOME

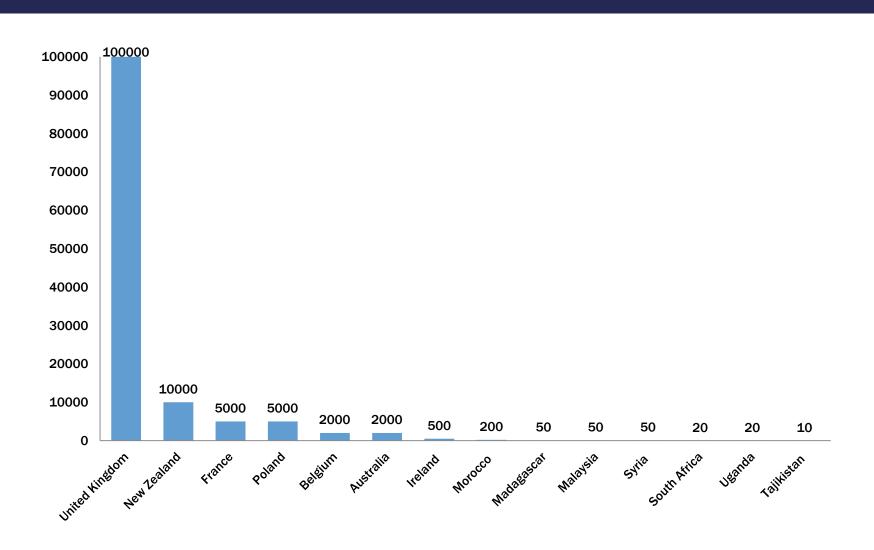

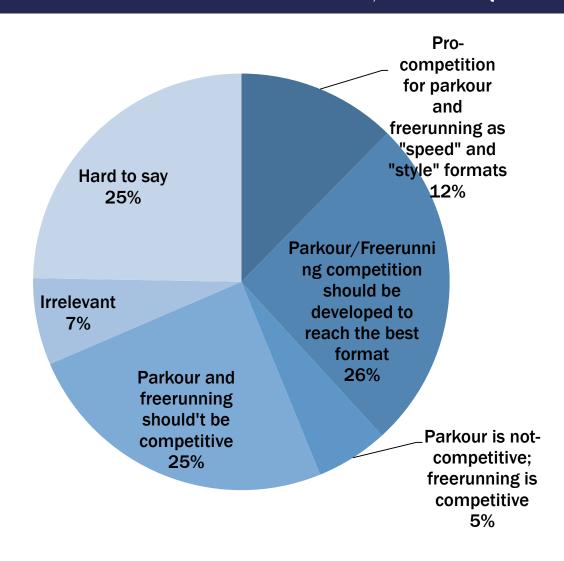
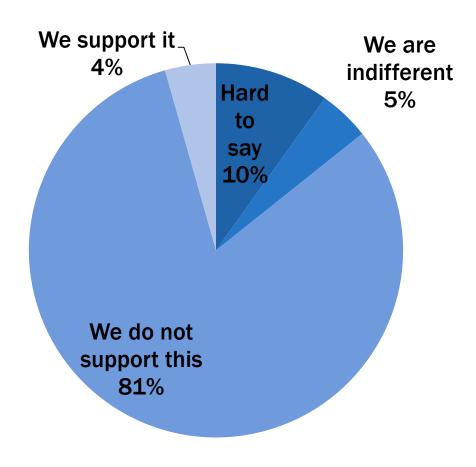
